



## FFCA HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

### Scholarship: High School Campus Society Physical Education Scholarships

**Description:** Two scholarships awards are provided by the FFCA High School Campus Society to the graduating FFCA High School students who demonstrated outstanding character, leadership, and teamwork within the FFCA Physical Education Program. The student's skills and knowledge of the Physical Education Program are considered exemplary.

**Value:** \$1,000.00 (each high school campus)

**Eligibility:** To be eligible for this award, the students must be a graduating grade twelve student who participated in the Physical Education 10/20/30 Program. The students also achieved a mark of 90% or greater in Physical Education 30. The students will be someone who consistently demonstrates the positive behaviours and habits in line with the core character virtues at FFCA and who plans on attending a post-secondary program.

**Time Limit:** This award must be used within two years following the end of the student's grade twelve year. The award will be paid directly to the recipient's choice of accredited post-secondary institution upon confirmation of registration.

**Criteria:** Students may nominate themselves, by parents, or by staff. The nominator (student or the nominee) must submit **a completed application form** along with **a statement (typed)** of not more than 500 words indicating why the nominated would be an excellent recipient of this scholarship. The statement should include the following evidence that the nominee:

- Is considered exemplary in the physical education program.
- Includes understanding of theory and the ability to apply what is learned.
- Always:
  - inclusive and empathetic towards others,
  - respects the school's and others' property,
  - demonstrates fair play while playing by the rules,
  - uses positive language,
  - prepared and punctual for class,
  - engaged in and on task for class activities,
  - willing to try new activities, and
  - questions for clarification

With the application the nominee should provide **two references** (name and contact information). These references could be their teachers, coaches, adult supervisor or mentors from the organizations they work or volunteer at.

#### Selection Process:

The award winners will be selected by a committee comprised of administration, staff, and members of the FFCA High School Campus Society.

**Deadline:** May 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022 (Applications will be available online on April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022)
