



## FFCA HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

### Scholarship: Southeast Elementary Campus Society Excellence in Science Scholarship

**Description:** This award is provided by the FFCA Southeast Elementary Campus Society to be given to a graduating FFCA High School student, one for each high school campus, who has demonstrated an outstanding understanding of the Science curricular criteria throughout their years in FFCA High School. This person has consistently shown a positive attitude towards learning, and has proven himself or herself capable of applying science based knowledge in and outside of the classroom.

**Value:** \$1,000.00 (each high school campus)

**Eligibility:** To be eligible for this award, the applicant must be a graduating grade twelve student with a satisfactory standing in all subjects (C grades or better) who consistently demonstrates the positive behaviours and habits in line with the core character virtues at FFCA and who plans on attending a relevant post-secondary program. Recipient should have an academic average of over 80% in science courses and have completed, or be in the process of completing, at least two 30 level courses in the sciences. These applications would be reviewed by a panel of 2-3 teachers in the Science department.

**Time Limit:** This award must be used within two years following the end of the student's grade twelve year. The award will be paid directly to the recipient's choice of accredited post-secondary institution upon confirmation of registration.

**Criteria:** Students may nominate themselves, or be nominated by other students, by parents, or by staff. The nominator (student or other person) must submit a **completed application form** along with a statement (typed) of not more than 500 words indicating why the nominee would be an excellent recipient of this scholarship. The statement should include the following:

- The nominee should be planning on entering a science-based program at the post-secondary level.
- The nominee's approach to science should be one of interest and wonder more than simply grade oriented, measured by level/type of participation, attitude, and questioning skills.
- Evidence supporting this interest in science outside of the curricular content, for example science fair, volunteer experience, future plans, hobbies, etc.
- The nominee should seek to understand cross curricular links and the importance of a well-rounded education.
- The nominee should maintain a 75% average in at least two 30 level science courses.

With the application the nominee should provide **two references** (name and contact information). These references could be their teachers, coaches, adult supervisor or mentors from the organizations they work or volunteer at.

#### Selection Process:

The award winner will be selected by a committee composed of administration, staff, and members of the FFCA Southeast Elementary Campus Society.

**Deadline:** May 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022 (Applications will be available online on April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022)
