

FFCA HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Scholarship: Southeast Elementary Campus Society Excellence in Social Studies Scholarship

Description: This award is provided by the FFCA Southeast Elementary Campus Society to be given to a graduating

FFCA High School student, one for each high school campus, who has demonstrated an outstanding understanding in the Social Studies department, and who has consistently applied their knowledge inside

and outside of the classroom.

Value: \$1,000.00 (each high school campus)

Eligibility: To be eligible for this award, the applicant must be a graduating grade twelve student with a satisfactory

standing in all subjects (75% or better) who consistently demonstrates the positive behaviors and habits in line with the core character virtues at FFCA and who plans on attending a relevant post-secondary program.

These applications would be reviewed by a panel of 2-3 teachers in the Social Studies department.

Time Limit: This award must be used within two years following the end of the student's grade twelve year. The award

will be paid directly to the recipient's choice of accredited post-secondary institution upon confirmation of

registration.

Criteria: Students may nominate themselves, or be nominated by other students, by parents, or by staff. The

nominator (student or other person) must submit a completed application form along with a statement (typed) of not more than 500 words indicating why the nominee would be an excellent recipient of this scholarship. The statement should include an explanation of the student's personal ideology on the

importance of active citizenship. In lieu of writing, this could also be done as a speech.

• A resume of activities demonstrating active citizenship which should include both school and home community involvement.

A 75% average or higher in Social Studies 30.

Pursuit of a degree in a Bachelor of Arts program with a major in Social Sciences/Humanities.

With the application the nominee should provide **two references** (name and contact information). These references could be their teachers, coaches, adult supervisor or mentors from the organizations they work or volunteer at.

Selection Process:

The award winner will be selected by a committee composed of administration, staff, and members of the FFCA Southeast Elementary Campus Society.
